An Important Message About the Future of Epsilon-Gamma

brother,

By now you have received the Sig House campaign packet and our follow-up emails requesting your support. **This is the email asking you to take action.** We need your assistance, and we need it now.

On **August 15**, the construction loan on the Sig House will be converted into a long-term mortgage, and our monthly payment will be established. Every dollar contributed **before August 1** helps reduce the loan principal and lowers that monthly payment for years to come. Gifts made after August 1 will still make a difference, but the gifts made **today** will have the greatest impact.

The good news is that this challenge is absolutely within our reach—**if every brother does his part.** The chapter is thriving, the house is full, and we are excited about the quality of the young men joining Epsilon-Gamma. We are not asking a handful of brothers to carry the entire load. We are asking every brother to shoulder a small part of it.

According to our fundraising experts, campaigns like ours are most successful with approximately **40% participation** and an average gift of about **\$6,000**. Today, we have **149 donors - about 10% of our alumni - with an average gift of more than \$10,000**. Some heavy lifters have already stepped forward. Now we need more brothers to carry the load. To reach our participation goal, we need approximately **580 brothers** to become donors.

Whether your gift is **\$100, \$200, \$500, \$1,000, \$2,500, \$5,000, or more**, it matters. Every gift reduces the debt. Every donor strengthens the campaign. Every brother who participates helps secure the future of our chapter.

Many of us remember Hawaiian Party workdays; so now is a good time for a Hawaiian Party analogy: If fifty Kappa Sigs were in the woods and needed to carry a forty-foot red oak log out, how many would it take?

We don't know the exact number—but we know it would take **a lot more than five...or 10% of the team.**

That's exactly where we are today.

The mortgage on the Sig House is the biggest, heaviest load Epsilon-Gamma has ever carried. Right now, too few brothers are carrying too much of that weight. We need more hands. We need more

shoulders. And yes, we'd like to help pull Brothers **Jerry Lorey** and **Scott Hill** out from underneath that log before it comes down on them.

If you wish to be asked nicely, we say to you **"Please make a gift."**

If you respond best to a push, we say to you **"Step up and contribute."**

If you need arm-twisting, we are not going to do that. We want you to want to give on your own.

We are not asking anyone to carry the whole load. We are simply asking every brother to help carry it.
